Dear colleagues!

In accordance with the Plan of Scientific Congresses and Conferences of the Ministry of Sport of the Russian Federation and within the framework of the Year of Science and Technology in 2021, the «Volgograd State Physical Education Academy» arranges the 1st International Scientific and Practical Conference «**Theoretical and methodical approaches to the training of specialists for the sphere of physical education, sports and tourism**».

Date: October 20-21, 2021.

Venue: Volgograd State Physical Education Academy, 78 Prospect V.I. Lenina, Volgograd, Russia.

Language of the Conference: Russian, English.

The following are invited to participate in the conference: professors and scientific staff of institutes of physical education, scientists of scientific research institutes of physical education and sport, basic research laboratories, specialists in sports medicine, physiology, biochemistry, psychology, pedagogy, sociology, philosophy, adaptive physical education, adaptive sport, leading trainers and pedagogical-practitioners, managers of enterprises in the sphere of hospitality and tourism.

The main directions of the conference are:

1. Sports-methodical problems of preparing specialists in various sports.
2. Socio-humanitarian and psychological-pedagogical problems in improving the training of specialists in the field of physical education, sports and tourism.
3. Medical and biological aspects of specialists' training in sports.
4. Management and marketing of physical education, sports and tourism.

In order to support the research work of young scientists, **the Conference arranges an International Contest for the Best Scientific Work of Young Scientists and Students of Higher Educational Organizations (see Annex. 3).**

The format of the conference is mixed: participation is possible in both in-person and remote technologies (live video with the possibility to participate in presentations and discussions).

Forms of participation in the conference

1. Oral report (no publication).
2. Report and publication.
3. Participation by correspondence (report only).

Arrangements for participation in the conference

Reception of articles for publication in the collection of scientific and practical conference until **1 October 2021**. The following materials should be sent to the Organizing Committee's e-mail address: vgafk.international@mail.ru

1. Article (or report) as required (annex 1).
2. Participant's application (annex 2).
3. Confirmation of payment of the organizational fee.

Each material must be filled in as a separate file under the name of *Section Number_Ivanov_request*: 1_Ivanov - article (for talking points and articles); 1_Ivanov - application; 1_Ivanov - payment.

Participation in the conference and provision of the electronic version of the collection of materials and the certificate of the conference participant –300 rub. Foreign participants and Doctors of science (without co-authors) are published free of charge.

All materials will be checked in the system antiplagiat.ru. Requirements for original text (body of article) - at least 70%.

Upon receipt of the materials, the Organizing Committee, within 5 working days, sends a letter to the author's e-mail address, either confirming the acceptance of the materials or proposing technical and (or) substantive amendments to the article. Authors who have sent materials by e-mail and have not received confirmation of their receipt by the organizing committee need to duplicate the application.

Proceedings of the Conference:

1. As a result of the conference, it is planned to publish a collection of conference materials with indexing in RSCI. 2. Articles distinguished by scientific novelty in the field of physiological and medical technologies, technologies of physical education of the younger generation, adaptive physical education of people with special needs, reflecting the main results of the thesis research and of interest to the wider scientific community, will be published in the journal «Physical Education and Sports Training» (included in the list of peer-reviewed scientific publications of the HAC of the Russian Federation).

Requirements for the presentation of materials

1. Works should not be previously published or sent for publication to other publications.

2. All articles submitted for publication are subject to peer review (peer review), resulting in a final decision by the Organizing Committee as to whether to publish the submissions. **The authors are legally and otherwise responsible for the facts, content and literacy of the material provided.** The article will be published in the author's editorial. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make minor corrections to material that does not affect the meaning of the text.

3. No more than 3 articles may be submitted by a single author.

4. Requirements for presentation:

Articles are submitted electronically, prepared in MS Word 2003-2016 text editors.

In the name of the report file, the number of the section should be in first place, followed by the name of the first author of the report. Example: 1_Ivanov_article.doc. ***The article may have no more than four authors.***

Article should be from 3 to 10 pages (including title, names of authors, name of organization, bibliographic list, tables and figures).

Paper size A4, fields (bottom, top, right, left) 2 cm, orientation - book. Font - Times New Roman, size 12 pt. The line spacing is single. The font - 12 pt - is allowed in the table and in the drawing labels. The hyphenation is disabled. Alignment is in the width of the page. The indent is 1.25 cm.

The following sections should be reflected in the article: rationale, purpose of research, methods of research, methodology, results of research, conclusions, bibliography.

The title of the article is printed in capital letters in the middle of the first line with no dots.

In line (italics with right alignment) are: the surname and initials of the author(s), degree and rank, e-mail (for communication with the author) the name of the organization, city, country.

The following is an abstract in Russian (100-150 words according to structure: purpose, methods, results of research, conclusions) and keywords (not more than 5 words).

The title of the article, the name and initials of the author(s), the degree, academic rank, the name of the organization, the city and the country follow in English.

An abstract and keywords follow in English.

Next, at intervals, with a paragraph indent - the main text.

No:

- page numbering
- the use of page breaks in text;
- use of automatic page-by-page links;
- use of automatic transfers;
- use of a diluted or compacted interval between letters.

Figures and tables should be numbered through. The names and numbers of the figures should appear below the figures, and the names and numbers of the tables above the tables. Tables, diagrams, drawings and formulae should not be out of field.

The illustrations in the text of the publication are provided by an additional separate file: for graphs and diagrams - Excel format (xls), for drawings - jpg formats.

The symbols, labels, scales, etc. in the drawings must be readable and proportional to the size of the drawing. The drawings and diagrams are black-and-white only, with a stroke.

Type formulae in MathType editors (Equation Editor) that are configured by default. Only those formulae that are referenced in the text are numbered.

Abbreviations (other than common and valid in print) must be decrypted.

At the end of the article (at intervals) the title Bibliographic list is printed. A correct description of the sources used in the literature lists is a guarantee that the quoted publication will be taken into account in the evaluation of the scientific activities of its authors and the organizations they represent. The list of literature is drawn up according to State Committee 7.0.5-2008 (no more than 8 sources!).

References to literature in the text of the article are in square brackets, for example: [1, 2] or [3-7].

STATUTE CONCERNING

the International Contest for the Best Scientific Work of Young Scientists and Students of Higher Educational Organizations within the framework of 1st International Scientific and Practical Conference «**Theoretical and methodical approaches to the training of specialists for the sphere of physical education, sports and tourism**».

1. General statutes

1.1. The International Contest for the Best Scientific Work of Young Scientists and Students (hereinafter referred to as the Contest) is held among students of higher educational institutions in order to:

to identify and attract young researchers who are oriented towards scientific activity and to solve current problems in the areas of physical education, adaptive physical education, sports and tourism;
to develop students' interest in the scientific heritage in the main scientific directions and intensifying research work.

1.2. The Contest is held in remote form among representatives of higher educational institutions.

1.4. The Contest is arranged and managed by an Organizing Committee.

2. Presentation of works

2.1. Scientific works may be submitted to the Contest: the texts of the reports and articles on the above topics.

2.2. Materials are drawn up in accordance with the requirements specified for the presentation of scientific works within the framework of this conference.

The text should be edited stylistically and technically. Audio and video materials, presentations are welcome.

2.3. For participation in the Contest scientific work is submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Contest in electronic form no later than October 1, 2021 at: vgafk.international@mail.ru with a mark in the topic of the letter «Student's Work Contest». Participation in the Contest is free of charge.

2.4. Submissions shall include:

- thesis of a scientific paper;
- application in accordance with the requirements in printed form;
- scan of the entry of a job to the Contest from the department or a faculty.

Participation in the Contest implies the consent of authors to publish material on behalf of authors in the open press (in the form of articles).

2.5. In case of violation of the conditions for the submission of documents, the work shall be exempted from the Contest.

3. Procedure for consideration and evaluation of works

3.1. The examination of all the works submitted to the Contest shall be conducted by a competitive commission.

3.2. The Contest Commission shall be formed by the Organizing Committee from among the members of the Organizing Committee, scientists and educators-practitioners.

3.3. The Scientific advisor must not be a member of the Commission.

3.4. The Competition Commission reviews, discusses and evaluates the work.

3.5. Expert examination of the works submitted to the Contest is carried out until October 20, 2021.

3.6. The results of the evaluation of the work by the members of the Commission shall be signed by all the members and the chairman of the Commission.

4. Procedure for awarding winners

4.1. On the basis of the decision of the Contest Commission, students who have won prizes in the Contest are awarded diplomas and their work will be published in a book.

4.2. Where there is a large quantity of work to be praised, the Contest Commission may award special prizes and mark the individual work of the participants.

4.3. The results of the Contest will be published on the website of the Academy after the examination of the reports, no later than October 25, 2021.
